

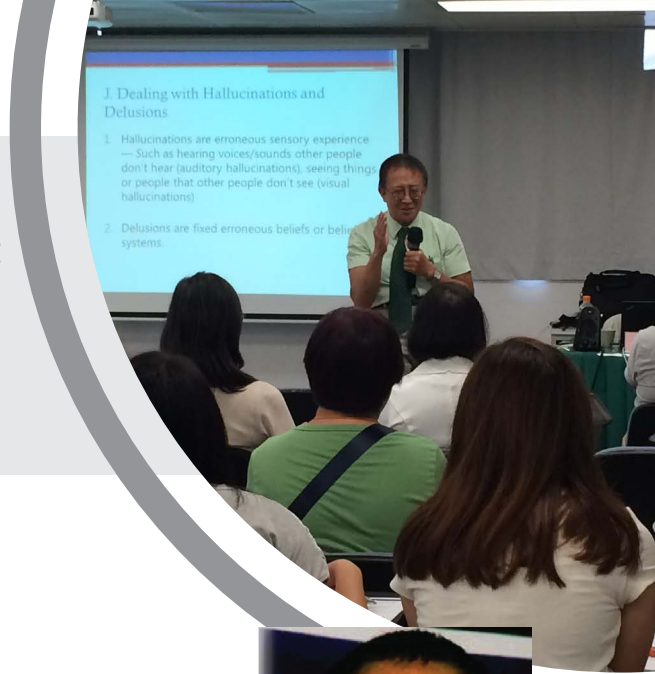

## COURSE OBJECTIVES

1. To outline the general principles of suicide risk identification, assessment, management and their practical applications to evaluating and working with adolescents and youths who are at risk.
2. To present psychotherapeutic and behavioral intervention strategies in managing suicide risks and behaviors.
3. To understand the impact of mental health problems and psychiatric disorders such as Major Depressive Disorder, Bipolar Disorder, Trauma Disorders, Developmental Issues on the suicide risk of adolescents and youths.
4. To present the complex and challenging phenomenon of self-injurious/ self-harming behaviors such as self-cutting, self-burning, self-hitting, hair pulling etc. and how they differ from suicide gestures and attempts.
5. To provide assessment and treatment tools to work with clients engaging in such behavior.
