researching CBT-CSCA as a key intervention for ASD.

After joining iREACH, she has been intensively working with adolescents with ASD, through rendering individual-based and group-based interventions.



Course Description

The prevalence of ASD is on an increasing trend (CDC, 2014) and the service demands are expanding rapidly. Different educational, clinical and rehabilitation professionals have to get well-equipped to meet this rising population. Working with people challenged by ASD calls for multiple knowledge and skills ranging from individual, family to group. There are various interventions for ASD and only a few have good evidence base (Lai, Lombardo & Baron-Cohen, 2014). Intensive behavioural approach has been proven to be effective for young children with ASD and for adolescents and adults; cognitive training is found to play an essential complementary role (Chan, Lo & Tang, 2014). Through this group, practical knowledge and skills in both approaches grounded on CBT framework will be disseminated via a group supervision format.
