Course Objective

Motivational interviewing (MI) has been clinically and empirically proven as an evidence-based method to help clients resolve ambivalence and mobilize their energy, commitment, and personal resources for change. It continues to gain momentum as a powerful tool in the treatment of a wide range of psychological problems. Our trainer, Dr. Paul Kong, will describe ways to combine MI with other treatments for various psychological problems, including depression, anxiety disorders, eating disorders, posttraumatic stress disorder, and others. The course will illustrate the nuts and bolts of intervention, using vivid clinical examples, and review the empirical evidence base. During the course, Dr. Paul Kong will show how to tailor MI to each population's needs, whether used as a prelude of treatment or throughout the course of therapy. Mental health professionals in any setting will benefit from this course, including clinical psychologists, psychiatrists, clinical social workers, counselors, addiction specialists, and psychiatric nurses.
